



APDR 'THE MONEY SHOT' WITH GATORADE EVENT TERMS, CONDITIONS & EXCLUSIONS

The following conditions must be adhered to for any hole-in-one to be deemed eligible to win the advertised prize.

It is an event condition precedent that;

1. there will be a maximum of 120 amateur attempts per event. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis at the specified starting time of the event. Professional golfers of any standing are not eligible to enter.
2. the hole in one must be scored;
 - a. as a recognised attempt using the designated ball allocated to the competitor at the event,
 - b. during the official published hours of the event,
 - c. from the specified tee off location for the event,
 - d. into the official hole for the event,
 - e. witnessed by the event organisers and the required independent witness (details below),to be deemed eligible to win the advertised prize.
3. there is a maximum of one shot per person per event.
4. there is a maximum of one hole-in-one per event. If a hole-in-one is scored during an event, the event will be deemed ended immediately for future competitors, and any paid entry fees for competitors who have not completed their chance to attempt will be refunded.
5. only standard golf equipment recognised as within the Rules of Golf and/or by the PGA may be used.
6. the minimum yardage from the hitting area to the hole is 125 metres for amateur Men & 125 metres for amateur Ladies.
7. the hole will not be modified from its original state for this event.
8. prior to their attempt all competitors must have paid the specified entry fee and completed the official *Competitors Entry Form*. This must be handed to the event organiser in exchange for a designated competition entry ball which will be the only ball that is eligible to be used for this competitor to compete for the prize.
9. current APDR staff, event partners or registered official event witnesses are not eligible to enter.
10. once a ball has been struck and has come to rest, that ball can no longer qualify for a hole-in-one (i.e. if a subsequent golf ball strikes that stationary ball and it ends up in the hole the prize is not awarded). If a ball is struck and whilst still in motion hits a stationary ball and the struck ball ends up in the hole this will constitute a valid attempt and the prize will be awarded (subject to complying with the remaining Event Terms, Conditions & Exclusions of the event).

HOLE IN ONE WITNESS REQUIREMENTS

It is an event condition precedent that each individual attempt will be witnessed by one competent independent non-playing adult witness, aged 18 or older, who is to supervise the target hole. The witness is to be supplied by APDR.

Independent shall mean an individual aged over 18 who is not a player in the competition or employed by Albert Park Driving Range Pty Ltd, the prize supplier or event partners, and who is capable of verifying any successful attempt and verifying compliance with the terms and conditions of the event.

Any failure to comply with these conditions will render a hole-in-one ineligible to receive the advertised prize.

PLEASE NOTE

1. In the event of scoring an eligible hole-in-one, the competitor will be required to provide current proof of identification and complete further documentation to receive the advertised prize. Any advertised prize will not be paid out on the date of the event.
2. In the event of a hole-in-one, APDR and their event partners reserve the right to use the competitor's name and image to promote the successful event on through their own media channels and public media channels.
